Curious Learners Value: Wonder	To generate curiosity about what we teach and allow it to take hold into something that becomes a passion for lifelong learning for all of our children. Openly involve them in their learning by meeting them where they are and then showing them where they can go exploring their interests, expanding upon their ideas, and engaging them in meaningful dialogue which encourages them to fully engage with owning and developing their own learning. Courageous Learners Value: Resilience	To cultivate a growth mindset from the perspective of building courage, encourage failure by modelling it and showing how to reframe events in a positive light, so children are willing to try new things whilst embracing failure and the opportunities it brings. Let the children learn to have control over their own actions, including trying again if they don't succeed. Independent Learners Value: Truth	We will develop our children into independent learners to empower them to take control of their own learning – both inside the classroom. Teachers have faith that our pedagogical approach cultivates independent habits of mind in the students we teach and the children want to explore the truths of the world for themselves.
